DRAIN MEASUREMENT RECORD

This is a place to record how much fluid is collecting in each drain. Please **bring this with you each time you come to the office**.

Make sure you are taking an antibiotic medication as long as you have a drain. Your antibiotic is probably either
cephalexin, azithromycin, clindamycin, or sulfamethoxazole. Call the office for a refill if you are running out of
your antibiotic or if you do not know which antibiotic you are taking. Remember, if you have a drain, you should
be taking an antibiotic.
Measure and record in cc's (also known as ml's) the amount of fluid collected in each drain three times a day.
Record the date in the first column and the time of day you are doing the measurement in the second column.
Record the amount you measure from your first drain in the column labeled "Drain 1", the amount you measure
from the second drain under "Drain 2", and so on.
